WHO ARE ALLIED HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS?

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt of India has recommended the following definition: “Allied Healthcare Professionals (AHPs) includes individuals involved with the delivery of health or healthcare related services, with qualifications and competence in therapeutic, diagnostic, curative, preventive and/or rehabilitative interventions. They work in multidisciplinary health teams in varied healthcare settings including doctors, nurses and public health officials to promote, protect, treat and/or manage a person(‘s) physical, mental, social, emotional, environmental health and holistic well-being. The scope of allied health practice extends to the individual, the family and to the community.

In March 2011, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare nominated the Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) as its technical partner and constituted the National Initiative for Allied Health Sciences (NIAHS) secretariat with a mandate to develop a framework to improve allied health training, education and regulation in the country.

BJS Trust strives to provide an overarching framework to realign human resources in accordance with the growing demands of the health sector in the State of Punjab.

FOR SC/ST/BC: 20% seats will be reserved in each course. Unfilled seats in SC/ST/BC category will be filled by General Category candidates.



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

ACADEMIC CRITERIA

1. Diploma Courses: 10+2 in ANY stream or with Science (for Xray/CT Scan /MRI/imaging) passed or its equivalent from a recognized Board/University. Candidates who have appeared for +2 exams of any Board or University and are awaiting results, are eligible to apply.
2. RPL (Recognition of prior learning as per National Skill development Initiative): Candidates who are already working in any hospital/nursing home/diagnostic centre/ medical, dental, physiotherapy college and practicing a particular skill for the past 2 years or more but have not been certified by any Board for their skill in healthcare, are also eligible to apply.

All fee must be paid in full on admission and at the commencement of next session as per notification by the College Authorities.

Registration fee and annual fee is non-refundable. A candidate who fails to pay the second year fee in the prescribed time will not be allowed to continue classes.

Overseas students /NRI Candidates (if not an Indian citizen) must have a 'Provisional Student Visa' from the Indian mission abroad, before admission, and thereafter NOC from Ministry of Health & Family welfare is obtained, on the basis of which the Provisional Student Visa is converted to full-time Student Visa for the duration of the Course. Candidates are advised to go through the 'Visa Manual' of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, and ensure that the correct procedures are followed before applying for an Allied Course. Admitted candidates will be required to be registered with the concerned FRRO/FRO.

STEPS FOR SECURING ADMISSION IN ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSE:

Application is to be submitted online after payment of Rs 1,000/- application fee (non-refundable). The application form can be downloaded from the website of the institute. Payment can be made online at the time of submission (online) of the application.

Application can be submitted in person also with fee at the college admission office. (No documents at the time of application are required to be submitted).

For General applicants:

The applicants will be called for counselling and selection as per their merit (in +2 marks) for the course applied after last date. The date of first counselling will be notified on the college website. On the day of application the selected candidate is required to submit the following documents:

Copy of the adhaar card

Copy of 10th, +1 and +2 certificates.

Four (4) passport size photographs against a white background

Original documents will be seen for scrutiny at the time of admission.

Full Fee (registration and annual fee) will be deposited by the candidate at the time of admission.

For healthcare workers/ already employed applicants:

For applicants who are healthcare workers already working in a Hospital/ Nursing Home/Clinic/Government centres are required to submit the following:

- Certificate of experience by the Incharge/Employer stating number of years of experience and basic qualifications at the time of appointment.
- Copy of their highest School/College certificate.
- Four (4) passport size photographs
- Full fee for one year duration + registration fee

Health workers who are already employed can avail admission under RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) wherein they may continue with their employment in a healthcare organisation and will attend college for theory class (3-4 hours/week). RPL, depending on the years or prior experience can give you opportunity to appear for final examination at the end of one year.

Employment after completion of these Courses:

The diploma is recognised by Govt of India as it is given by BSS, a national development agency established by Planning Commission, Govt of India which has been doing so for the past more than 50 years.

The college will assist candidates in placement and employment in private/public health organisations as per their skills and achievements though it does not guarantee any candidate for appointment.

The institute will issue letters for 'Good-Conduct' to all candidates who conduct themselves in a manner as per rules during the course of their study. The institute will provide letter of reference for candidates wishing to apply for employment in one of the Organisations which are liaising with BJS Dental College and Hospital, Guru Amar Das Hospital and Baba Jaswant Singh Trust in India and abroad.

The diploma certificates earned by the candidates are attested by Ministry of External Affairs for all candidates aspiring to apply abroad after payment of due attestation fee to the central office of BSS (the examining board).

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The general control of the Institute is vested in the Principal.
2. All students shall comply with the Institutional rules and regulations.
3. Ragging of any sort is forbidden and is punishable by fining, rustication or expulsion from college.
4. Regular and punctual attendance at lectures, demonstrations, clinical work, and class examinations is compulsory.
5. Leave of any kind must be sanctioned prior to absence.
6. It is preferable that students who are unwell are admitted under the care of the Staff & Students Health Services (SSHS) Physician at SGAD Hospital.
7. Any communication like notices etc. must be submitted through the Principal, who will forward them if considered desirable.
8. Students are not permitted to receive presents or money from the hospital patients.
9. Students must pay for all damages caused by them to books and other college property.
10. Gambling, possession or use of alcoholic beverages, possession or consumption of any addicting or psychotropic drugs, smoking etc strictly prohibited.
11. Students who do not maintain a satisfactory academic standard will not be allowed to hold posts like class representative or office bearer of the students council in the Institute or take part in extra-curricular activities.
12. Irregularities, neglect of duties, breach of rules and indiscipline will be dealt with and necessary action taken by the Principal, and the heads of the departments, as the case may be.

Hostel Facilities:

Students may avail hostel facilities subject to availability of rooms and will be charged as per rules.

DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY

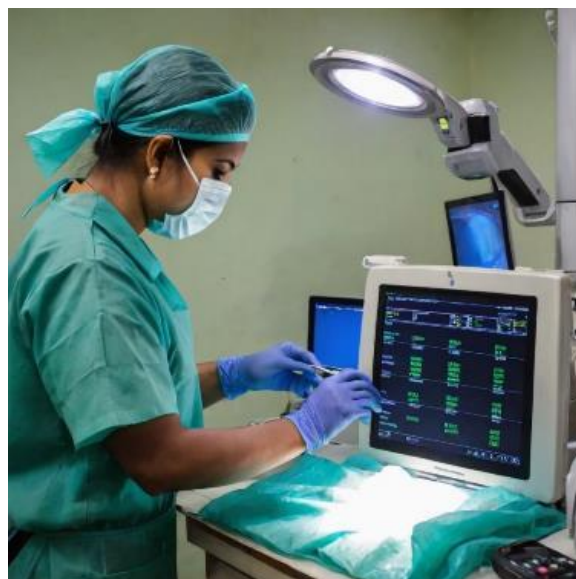

DIPLOMA IN OPERATION THEATRE TECHNOLOGY:

OT technicians play a critical role in maintaining a sterile environment, preparing surgical equipment, and providing support to the surgical team.



DIPLOMA IN DENTAL MECHANIC COURSE:

The role of a dental mechanic, also known as a dental lab technician or dental laboratory technician, encompasses a range of tasks involved in the fabrication of dental prosthetics and appliances. These professionals work in dental laboratories, often in collaboration with dentists, prosthodontists, and orthodontists, to create custom-made dental devices according to patient specifications and dentist prescriptions.



DIPLOMA IN DENTAL HYGIENE TECHNOLOGY:

The role of a dental hygienist is essential in promoting and maintaining oral health within the community. Dental hygienists work under the supervision of dentists to provide preventive dental care and educate patients on proper oral hygiene practices.



DIPLOMA IN DENTAL OPERATING ROOM ASSISTANCE (DORA):

The role of a dental operation room assistant, also known as a dental surgical assistant or dental operating room technician, is vital in providing support during dental procedures, particularly surgical and invasive treatments.

DIPLOMA IN DENTAL CHAIR ASSISTANT COURSE:

The role of a dental chair assistant, also known as a dental assistant or dental chairside assistant, is crucial in supporting dentists during patient examinations, treatments, and procedures. Dental chair assistants work directly with dentists to ensure the smooth and efficient operation of the dental office. It is a combination of clinical skills, organizational abilities, and interpersonal communication skills



EXAMINATIONS:

Candidates will be required to pass the periodic examinations and term examinations conducted by the Institute.

The final accreditation examination will be conducted by the Central Bharat Sevak Samaj, a National development establishment sponsored by Planning Commission Government of India. All attestations of final diploma and certificates for the Overseas Candidates (and those applying for overseas jobs) will be done by Ministry of External Affairs through the Central BSS office at New Delhi.

Minimum pass percentage will be 50% of maximum marks both in theory and practical.

The medium of teaching and examinations shall be English.
